RE: ATI TRAINING AND DOCUMENTATION DEADLINE

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As the GNY Education Fund has informed you, the deadline for the completion of training and documentation for Advanced Training Initiative (ATI) is December 31, 2020.

As you already know, the Fund is offering 2 free training options; each of these will satisfy your training obligation under the ATI program. The following is the information the Executive Director of the GNY Education Fund, Sandi Vito, has already sent to your facility regarding their ATI training options:

Dear ATI Administrator:

I hope you are well. This message contains important information about the training requirement for your Advanced Training Initiative (ATI) funding. As you may remember, the resources released by the New York Department of Health (NYDOH) for this training initiative are the subject of a collective bargaining agreement. NYDOH set the deadline of **December 31, 2020** for the completion of your ATI training and documentation.

The 1199SEIU Training and Employment Funds are pleased to offer two courses—at no additional cost to you—that will fulfill your ATI training requirement. Please choose one of the following ATI courses for your staff members:

**PDPM (Patient Driven Payment Model) Training for Nursing Home Workers** is a NEW four-hour e-course consisting of four, one-hour modules. We recommend that you use this course to fulfill your training requirement. Here is a link to the PDPM course: <https://1199tuf.hwapps.org/courses/pdpm/>

**Resident Decline Detection Program** is a four-hour video consisting of four, one-hour modules. If you previously received ATI funding, you may already have enrolled your staff in this course.
