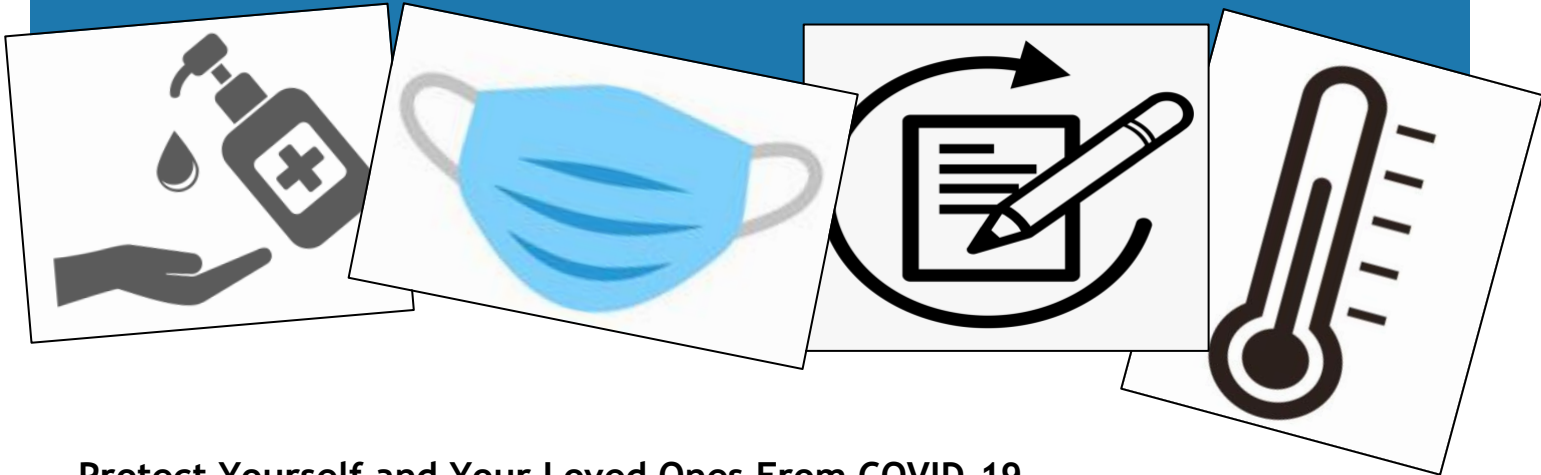


COVID-19 VISITOR GUIDANCE

Protect Yourself and Your Loved Ones From COVID-19

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use Alcohol Based Hand Sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick and stay home if you are sick.
- You must wear a face mask or face covering in public when social distancing is not possible.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Remember to maintain physical distancing precautions of at least 6 feet.

Visitor Guidance

- Visitors must sign in and will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to the visit. If a visitor has symptoms or is Covid positive within 48 hours after visit, please inform the facility.
- Visitors must wear a facemask or face covering and will be provided a mask if they do not have one.
- Hand sanitizer will be used before and after the visit and as needed.
- Visitors are not permitted to walk throughout the facility and must stay in the designated visiting areas.
- There will be no more than 2 visitors per session.
- The facility recommends visitors have a Negative Covid test within 72 hours of visit. **(FACILITY INSERT SPECIFIC TESTING INFO)**
- If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will not be permitted to visit or asked to leave.
- * *Visitors are highly encouraged to get vaccinated.*
